Our first newsletter of the year. Welcome to all our existing and new families to the Green room.

As you are all aware, we are using Hubhello (our preschool software program) to share your child's observations and photos. This is a new process for us so please be patient as we navigate through using this software. Any feed back you can provide to us through the app will be of huge benefit to us so please write comments.

We have been busy so far, we have been reinforcing handwashing. This helps create practises for the children to continue the fight against covid. This works towards the learning outcome 3 of the EYLF where children take increasing responsibility of their own health and physical well-being.

We have also been completing the children's first progress reports for the year. This gives us initial information on where your child is at and helps us plan for their strengths and needs for the year. You will find an observation on this on hubhello as we complete them.

The children will also participate in Seapart testing from the Literacy and Numeracy Foundation on Monday which gauges the children's literacy levels as a base to track their progress over the year.

We have seen our literacy program in action everyday with the children. We are currently introducing the language we use when guiding their writing. Eg short line, tall line, slanty line. This has been in many of the children's activities including playdough, cutting, stories and drawing. The children have also spontaneously included this in their block constructions. We have extended on this by introducing house plans where the children used short lines and long lines to create their plans. The children have also created paddle pop stick creations where they not only used literacy skills

We will end the term with easter activities and the children making an esater hat to use in their easter egg hunt during the last week of term.


